### INTRODUCTION

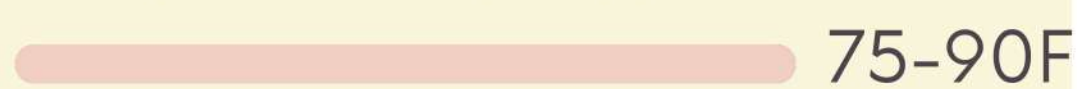

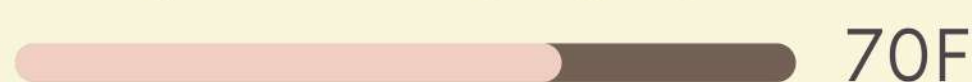

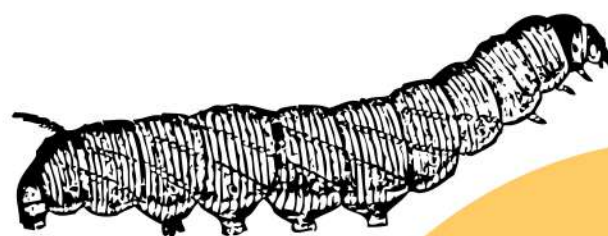

### ENCLOSURE BASICS

Ideal Tank for 1 Veiled Chameleon:  
X-Large Reptibreeze

Chameleons are arboreal reptiles that love to climb, so we recommend to decorate your enclosure with plenty of branches, vines, and plants. The best enclosure type to have a veiled chameleon in is the Zoo Med Reptibreeze, as they are specifically made with chameleons in mind, allowing for proper ventilation and optimal climbing space.

### MORE INFO

Veiled chameleons need both a source of heat and a source of UVB for a 12 hour cycle daily. We recommend a reptile basking spot heat lamp, as well as a full-spectrum UVB bulb or tube. This is to ensure proper temperature and calcium absorption. Even if UVB lighting is being used, we still also strongly recommend gut-loading crickets and supplementing with vitamin and calcium powders. Chameleons will mainly eat crickets, and can be given a variety of worms as a treat.
